JCAHO compliance is one of the most critical and time-consuming tasks faced by modern healthcare facilities organizations. Knowing which items have been inspected, which remain to be inspected, where they are located, whether they are deficient, their next inspection date, etc. can require dozens of spreadsheets, reports, annotated paper plans and days of reconciliation every year.

Our JCAHO Compliance Tracking System links the information about the relevant program elements directly to the floor plans, showing where the element is located, when it was last inspected, the compliance status and when it is scheduled for inspection next.

Coordinated inspection schedules detailing which items must be inspected this time period, along with color-coded and keyed plans, quickly guide your inspectors to the correct areas. All inspection results are entered into a single system which tracks condition, compliance and inspection history. The Facilities Administrator can then print JCAHO Summary reports with the click of a button.

A Plan for Improvement (PFI) module can be added to the basic system which allows you to integrate supporting information into your summary reports.

For further efficiency, the Compliance Tracking System can be integrated with your Work Order System, allowing any items marked deficient to be immediately scheduled for repair or replacement.
