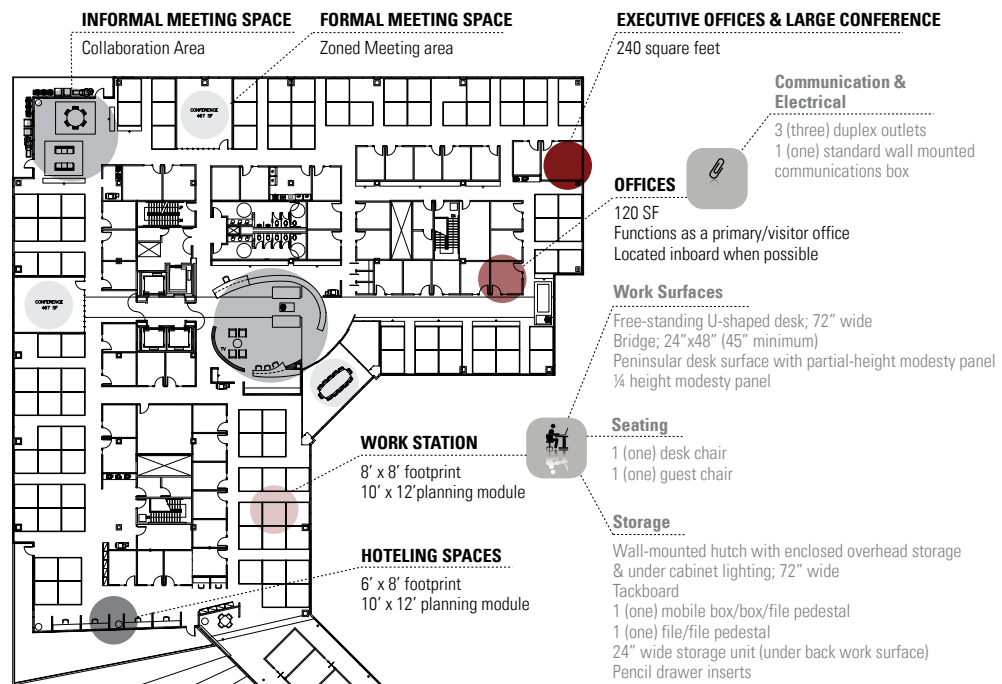


WORKSPACE STANDARDS ASSESSMENT & DEVELOPMENT
